

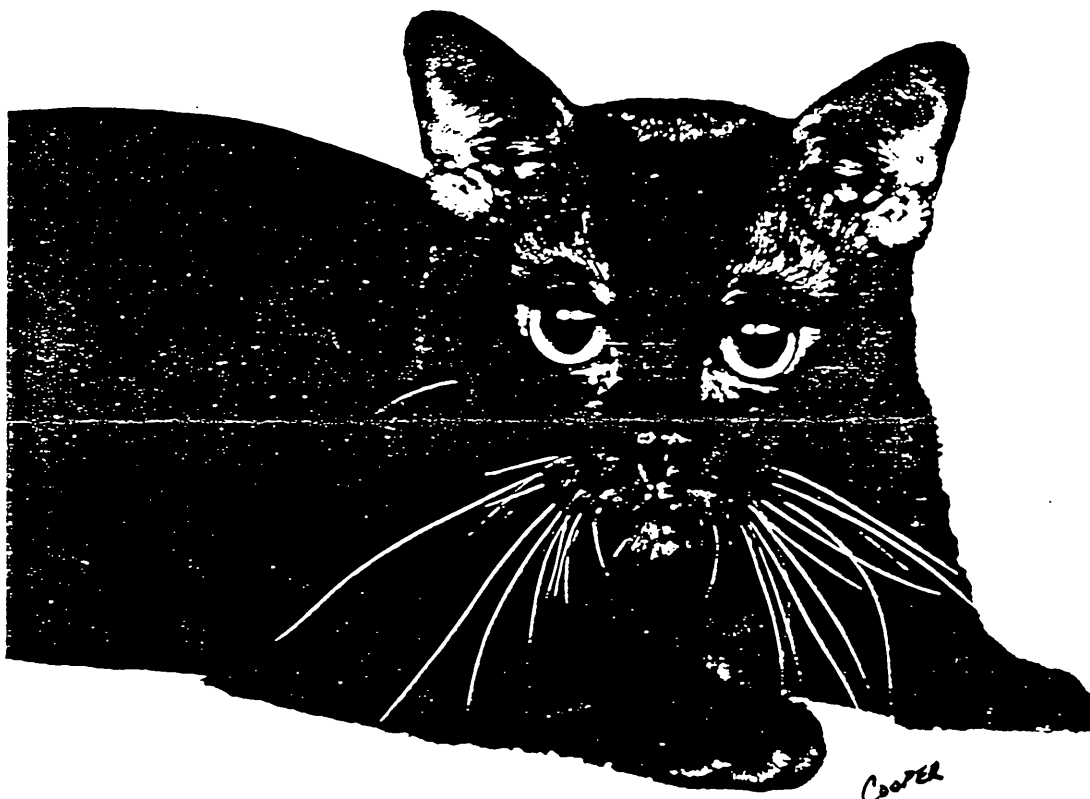

CFA'S 3rd BEST CAT AND NATIONAL BEST BURMESE

Turbo was shown in 35 shows on his campaign bid. He ventured outside the confines of the Southwest Region to brave the "East Coast" crowd in September 1982 at the National Capitol Cat Show in Arlington, VA. From there he wowed them in Texas, New York, and Portland to name a few stopovers. Among his many wins was the honor of being the First Shorthair to go "Across the Board"

at the famous Houston Cat Show, in January 1983. One of his favorite cities seems to be San Bernadino; or was it Santa Barbara or San Francisco? Hum.....

Turbo is a beautiful, even-colored, warm, sable brown. He is large boned and solid. Those beautiful deep gold eyes are like "frosting on the cake", to quote a judge. His sire is Gr. Ch. Senshu's Teddy Bear of Pum-ko and mom is Gr. Ch. Maple Talisman of Abbadabbado.

Jim and Donna Cooper, of Alhambra, California, who call him "Turbie", are the proud breeders/owners of this magnificent Burmese. Since the end of the 1983 Show Season, Turbo has received a "personal" present from Gloria Ernst of McLean, VA, and his picture has been chosen for the KAL KAN CALENDAR!

GRAND CHAMPION MATIKI'S DAYDREAM BELIEVER

Gr. Ch. Matiki's Daydream Believer ("Bebe") was born on 2/24/81 to Ch. One Time Day-Tripper of Matiki and Gr. Ch. Chinquapin's Casino of Matiki. It was apparent very early that there was a different look about Bebe who was, at that time, still unnamed. Having never seen this "different" look so early in kittenhood, we were not really sure how it would develop. As the litter grew, Bebe developed a round head with a very short muzzle and very large eyes; we knew that we had something special! She also considered herself special, even at the early age of 4 weeks. Being the little lady that she was, and still is, she was content to stay apart from the rough and tumble play of her litter-mates. Instead, she demanded extra attention from her human family.

We realized that her extreme head type was considered to be controversial by many judges, however, most Burm breeders truly appreciated her sweet expression. Bebe was shown in approximately 24 shows in the Southern and Great Lakes regions during the past season. Her controversial look usually earned her a high place in the finals or nothing at all. She finished Best Burmese and 12th Best Cat in the Southern Region. It was a real pleasure to show her as she enjoyed the attention, even on "bath nights."

Bebe's pedigree shows no shortage of well-known Burmese greats. Her sire is a litter mate to Gr. Ch. Chinquapin's Puttin' on the Ritz, CFA's Best Burmese in the 81-82 show season. Her dam traces lineage to Gr. Ch. L Z's Pepsi and Kit Kin lines. Although her show career in the champion class has ended, Bebe continues to groom herself in front of the mirror and look hopeful when she sees activity involving suitcases or cat carriers! We are hoping for a litter from her in September.

Our thanks to all the breeders and judges who were so kind to Bebe and us.

For some of you, it's been a long year of disappointments, disenchantments, a feeling of being left out of knowing what's new in the Burmese breed and show world. Well, this issue will try to relieve the "what's going on in the shows" questions by giving you a most complete 1982-1983 SHOW SYNOPSIS, Regional and National, and future issues will hopefully lift you out of your disenchantments, disappointments, and quieries about what's new in the Burmese breed. The newsletter will be issued every two months, 6 x's a year.

Future issues of the newsletter will also have a Burmese Show Report and will feature articles called BURMESE BREEDER'S CORNER (BBC), FOUNDING MA'S AND PA'S, KIT 'n TIME, and 2 times a year, will also feature the OUTSIDE BURMESE STUD SERVICE. Also included will be classified ads and letters or articles of general interest.

The BBC will be a spotlight on Burmese breeders, featuring articles on breeders, how they got started, what their goals are, how long they've been breeding, etc.

The FOUNDING MA'S and PA'S will feature an article on the Older Burms found in many of the pedigrees today. It might answer your question, "who is that cat in my pedigree?"

Do you have a great little kitten, who made at least 1 final at a CFA show, and would love to let the world know about him/her, who his/her favorite friend is, favorite plaything, food, sleeping spot, and other items of interest? Submit an article (see attached form in back) for KIT 'N TIME, which will be featured in every newsletter.

We will also issue this fall, around mid Oct, an OUTSIDE BURMESE STUD SERVICE (OBSS) listing under separate cover, for your ease in filing (see form in back). Send the form in! All advertising is free. Please fill in the 2 generation pedigree as this will also be printed and may help save time for that someone searching for a good cross! The complete listing of OBSS will be sent with the newsletter 2 times a year, Fall and Spring, but may be requested at any time of the year. All new males will be printed each issue, along with changes to existing ones.

And now, on to the SHOW SYNOPSIS.
